Their office provides legal advice and representation regarding disputes that do not pertain to OSU. They can assist with issues such as landlord/tenant disputes, traffic infractions, consultations for criminal charges, expungement of records, immigration, DACA application and renewal, debtor/creditor advice, consumer law, divorce and uncontested child custody, name changes, gender and sex changes, finance and insurance, and estate planning.
